DEFINITION: Provide pre-hospital evaluation, treatment, and transportation of sick and/or injured victims. Operate in the emergency/non-emergency mode and provide transport, as well as no-transport service at an Advanced Life Support level.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Perform all interactions with the public and other agencies with a professional attitude of cooperation and an understanding.

Respond and provide pre-hospital medical care at the Advanced Life Support Level.

Perform under adverse working conditions.

Wear protective clothing for all weather situations and air borne, and blood and body fluid exposure protection.

Ride in an ambulance under code three conditions (red lights and siren) in all environmental conditions.

Provide care to medical and trauma patients.

Carry essential medical equipment (i.e., trauma/medical bag, oxygen bag, and cardiac monitor).

Perform various lifts and transfers of patients who may require the use of one or more of the following items: gurney, scoop stretcher or backboard, stair chair, neonate isolet, and possibly a two-person manual transfer.

Work with exposures to known and unknown diseases and work in confined spaces.

Attend all training necessary to maintain certifications and other training as required by the Emergency Response Coordinator.

Perform general maintenance/house-keeping work of Fire District property.

Follow instructions; adhere to directives, orders, standard operating procedures and policies & perform all other duties as assigned

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge of: Advanced Life Support Skills and procedures including, but not limited to Administering intravenous medications; (ALS); EKG interpretation and manual defibrillation; Performs accurate and complete physical patient assessments; Accurately reports information to Base Hospitals and Physicians; Pyramid Lake EMS medical protocols; firefighting and rescue principles, practices and procedures.

Ability to: utilize emergency medical equipment in a proficient manner; Communicates concisely, clearly and effectively in both written and verbal form; self-motivated; lift over 100 pounds; safely operate emergency vehicles in accordance with Tribal Law and Order Code and State Statutes; act in accordance with Tribal, State and Federal laws, regulations, operational procedures, policies and statutes; analyze firefighting hazmat and rescue situation and adopt an effective strategy toward mitigation of incident; understand the incident command system and operation office apparatus; walk, stoop, climb, twist, bend, run, sit, squat, kneel, and work in awkward positions while providing medical care to patient(s).

Must submit to an extensive background investigation, annual physical exam, drug screen, and required immunizations.

Must possess a valid Nevada driver's license and be insurable under the Tribe's vehicle insurance policy.

REQUIRED EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Minimum of 2 years of experience preferred in an ALS system. Must possess the following at time of appointment and continued employment: Valid/Current Nevada Paramedic certification; Valid/Current ACLS certification; Valid/Current BCLS Healthcare Provider (or equivalent) certification; Valid Class B Nevada Driver License.

Hazardous Materials Operations Level Certification; EMS Instructor; PALS, PEPP; and ITLS or PHTLS preferred.

The applicant shall be certified within 12 months: NWCG Red-Card certification (preferred but not required); NIMS ICS 100-200-700-800; State of Nevada Firefighter 1 or II (preferred but not required); State of Nevada Hazardous Material Operation Level; State of Nevada Class B driver's license with "F" endorsement; S-190 and S130 Basic Wildland Behavior (preferred but not required); Pyramid Lake Fire Rescue Driver Operator Course.
